Cooper called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. Cooper asked if the Board had issue with the agenda; hearing none the Agenda was approved.

CHAIR REPORT

Cooper noted he and Pratt would both be unable to attend the March 11 meeting. Menser has agreed to chair the meeting in their absence, Cooper asked for a motion. Neatherlin moved approval of allowing Menser to chair the March 11, 2020 meeting. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Cooper noted we should have a quorum for the March meeting; however, he did remind the Board to let staff know if they can't attend.

Also, Cooper stated, he would not be able to attend the April meeting. April is our annual meeting and we will be electing a chair and vice chair. Cooper did note he is willing to continue as chair if it is the pleasure of the Board. Menser noted he will not attend the April meeting either, however he will try to get an alternate.

Selection of Finance Committee

Each February we are to select a Finance Committee, Cooper explained. Per the By-laws, the committee is appointed by the Chair, however, Cooper stated he did speak with a Neatherlin and Pratt who both agreed to serve again. Cormier is unable to continue the committee. Cooper asked if there were any volunteers. Menser stated he would be willing to serve. It was noticed we wouldn't have a full committee for April 8. After some discussion, it was decided to move the meeting to April

1 at 9:00 am.

Selection of Personnel Committee

Cooper stated we do need an adhoc committee to perform a mid-contract evaluation and compensation review for McNair. Cooper did note Brotherton had agreed to serve on the Personnel Committee. Cooper asked for 2 other volunteers. McNair did note this meeting would follow the Board meeting. Winborn volunteered, as did Cathey. Cooper did state the committee will meet in March and we'd hope to have feedback for an April meeting for a final report to the full Board in May.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

CONSENT AGENDA

Cooper asked approval of the Consent Agenda. Neatherlin moved approval of the Consent Agenda. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

DIRECTORS REPORT

Compliance Program Update

R. Moody explained the rain dampened things a bit last month. We have been receiving marijuana complaints; however, it is still minor compared to the outdoor burn complaints we have received.

We did have a hearing last month and received a decision already, R. Moody stated. Myers added, it was our new attorney, Throgmorton, first case for ORCAA. The case was for outdoor burning and while PCHB did reduce the fine from \$500 to \$300, liability was upheld. McNair added, this was an important case in that it held the property owner liable, even though he wasn't on site.

Neatherlin asked about the Bayshore Store, whether they were complying. R. Moody stated he will look into it and get back to Neatherlin.

Cooper asked if our education in the cities and UGAs is having an impact. R. Moody stated he wasn't sure if we had enough data to make that determination. McNair stated education is critical. One of our asbestos contractors received a Notice of Violation and as part of the mitigation, he is getting contractors and some realtors together and Mike Shults, one of our inspectors, will talk to them about asbestos and demolition. McNair explained we have had a hard time getting realtors into these conversations. Neatherlin noted he is a realtor and asked what he could do to help. Neatherlin explained they have county-wide meetings, typically on Tuesdays. Neatherlin also added, if you have or can produce a video (5 Minutes) on YouTube to share, that would go a long way. Neatherlin also suggested staff get language on the MLS. Nelson stated he would contact them.

Myers added there had been 2 other appeals, PA Shell and Elma Gas. In both cases, they have agreed to pay the fines.

Engineering Program Update

Goodin stated McKinley Paper's approval for a portable generator has gone out. McKinley is working on retooling the mill and needed additional power. J & J Extreme Autobody has also been finalized.

Air Quality Program Update

Hadley explained she is going to include a year end summary with this month's report. January was a very clean month. We had a lot of rain and wind to keep the air clean. We did have 2 moderate days in Port Angeles. We did have a few days of incomplete data due to power loss and communication failures at a couple of sites.

The Mason County Saturation Study continues and for January we didn't get above 12 for any of the days. Hadley showed the permanent Saturation Study monitors are tracking well with our permanent monitor.

Still working on wrapping up the Community Toxics program. Hadley stated she is working closely with the students to complete the work.

As for the summary for 2019; the charts will show we lost a few days of data at most sites. For the most part, Hadley continued, we had good air quality. There were a few moderate days in Port Angeles and Lacey, one in Aberdeen; a few unhealthy for sensitive group days in Lacey and Port Angeles. Raymond site is not listed due to the fact it had been moved so we have incomplete data.

Hadley explained Ecology has a goal of 20 micrograms per meter cubed, which means no one site should exceed that number more than 8 times in a year. With the wildfires, in 2018, we were way over that number at all our sites and if we take wildfires out of the equation, we were under, except for Lacey which was 20.4. In 2019, we were well under those numbers as it was a very clean year.

The final slide showed the number of days in Lacey, in each of the years shown, where we were over the 20 micrograms per meter cubed. Fifteen days, in a 5-year period we were above the goal; starting in 2015, we have dropped to 6 days or lower (winter).

Education and Outreach

Nelson stated he has been running data on the woodstove program since 2012. We have had a successful Thurston County woodstove replacement program. Other than 2015-2016, we are doing more each year. This year, we sent in our 2nd quarter report to the state, ending December, and received a note from Ecology Woodstove Director Dave Grant. He told us that statewide there were a little over 150 woodstove replacements; of those 150, we completed 50. Nelson did remind the Board Ecology has set aside some additional funds, and we are hoping to request those funds soon.

We are doing the program in Clallam and Mason County as well; however, they are not showing the same growth as Thurston County. We continue to work with partners in those counties and have high hopes they will become more successful over time.

Nelson noted 'home show' season is upon us. We will be attending at Port Townsend and Clallam County in March. We have the Master Builders home show in Lacey that covers Thurston and Mason counties and it takes place in April. Staff also plans on continuing their periodic outreach to city and county planning and permitting departments. Because of turnover, it helps to touch base and retrain them on the requirements ORCAA has regarding permits and notifications for asbestos and demolition projects as well.

Finance/Administrative Update

Harding noted we are fully leased, as of March 1. Our leases bring in about \$5100 a month and helps cover the debt service, as well as the operations and maintenance of our building. As for our current budget, we are on track having collected 77% of our revenue and at 57% on expenditures.

We have begun working on the Fiscal Year 2021 budget and managers are submitting their department budgets as we begin development. Harding stated we have recently received notice of cancellation with our credit card company. Harding explained we were notified the regulations changed the debt responsibility from the agency to the individuals. We are looking for a new bank and will be taking care of this issue as soon as possible.

Our Wellness team is getting ready for our annual YMCA Fun Run. We have also submitted our E-Well City application for the 2% reduction in the cost of our premiums.

Executive Director's Report

McNair stated staff has a follow-up meeting planned regarding The Jungle. The date is in mid-March and we did invite Jim Pendowski from Ecology to join us. We have been watching the legislation to see if they will be setting aside monies for clean up; Pendowski would apply for those funds int the toxics account.

The 2020-2021 proposed federal budget is out, McNair stated. EPA is looking at 44% cut in the 103 and 105 grants. McNair reminded the Board we have seen a similar proposed cut in previous budgets, and we will just have to watch and see where this goes. We have continued to work with the EPA on the smoke management plan. DNR has been burning in the UGAs, even though the smoke management plan has yet to be approved.

There is a piece of legislation, 1974, which is saying that marijuana is an agricultural product. If that goes through, it does hamstring us from doing much of anything. Currently we deal with odor complaints, however if it goes through, if they are following good agricultural practices, we can't do anything. There is legislation that appears to be moving forward, McNair stated, and it gives counties and cities the ability to say yea/nay on licenses. It allows for cities and counties to look at land use and zoning, which is important because you should be able to say whether it meets the criteria.

GOOD OF THE ORDER

Cooper stated the city of Olympia implemented a new policy around direct deposit. There has been a lot of scams regarding direct deposit, targeting local government. Our mayor had a scammer try to change her direct deposit to another bank. Cooper stated the city no longer takes electronic changes; they must be done in person.

ADJOURNMENT

The meeting adjourned at 11:09 a.m.


