Cooper called the meeting to order at 10 a.m. and asked for roll call.

Cooper asked for approval of the agenda. Brotherton moved approval, the motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### CHAIR REPORT

Cooper reminded the group we will not be meeting in August. Also, we do have a celebration following this meeting; celebrating paying off our building and ORCAA's 55<sup>th</sup> year.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

#### CONSENT AGENDA

Cooper asked approval of the Consent Agenda. Neatherlin moved approval of the Consent Agenda. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Finalize Executive Director's 2023-2025 Performance Measures

Cooper explained Johnston's contract says the Board will review performance measures regularly and this year the review coincides with finalizing next year's budget.

Johnston noted he had put together four performance measure items: agency succession planning and management, an update to ORCAA's strategic plan, continue to develop the agency's performance management process, and continue updating ORCAA's IT infrastructure including the agency's databases. Johnston noted he has added specifics to the general information discussed with the Board in April and is happy to take feedback or answer questions. Johnston stated these will be the items he will work on over the next 2 years.

Cooper did note he continues to meet with Johnston monthly. These performance measures have been a topic of discussion and he feels they are on point. Johnston noted he feels they align well with what the agency needs to be doing to remain successful. Cooper and Brotherton agreed they are in line with comments received during the evaluation process.

Warne moved approval of the Executive Director's performance measures for 2023-2025. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### PUBLIC HEARING

#### FY2024 Budget

Johnston briefly highlighted a few items in the budget, noting there have been no changes since the May meeting when we went over it in detail. Our budget includes an increase in fees of 6.3% as well as 6.3% increase for assessments. We do expect to draw about 7% of our reserves to balance the budget, amounting to approximately \$200,000. The budget does include implementation of the salary survey results, as well as a 4% salary adjustment.

Brotherton noting occupancy is 100%, what is the impact if we do not maintain full occupancy? Harding said we have 7 rentals, and we work closely with our tenants. We have experienced minimal rental loss in the previous years. The majority of our tenants have been with us over 6 years and many have long term leases. We do not feel we will have an issue maintaining occupancy.

Cooper noted our tenants were paying our mortgage and now will be paying for building maintenance.

Brotherton added he recalled there will be a proposal for a new staff member in January, wondered if we are expecting more overlap as we get into succession planning, is that factored in. Johnston noted he does not have a plan as of yet but has been talking to staff that have talked about retirement. Johnston added it is possible we will be discussing 2 positions, rather than just 1, to assist with succession planning and transitions.

Neatherlin said he is never comfortable with dipping into the reserves, but with ORCAA the budget is done in a way that it usually comes in better than we think. It is rare we use much of the reserve.

Cooper opened the public hearing at 10:18 a.m. Cooper asked for comments. There were no comments on the FY2024 Budget. Cooper closed the hearing at 10:19 a.m. Cooper requested a motion.

Brotherton moved approval of the FY2024 budget as presented. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### **DIRECTORS REPORT**

#### Compliance Manager Update

R. Moody explained DNR declared moderate fire danger in our jurisdiction, resulting in the shutting down all land clearing burning. This morning, Clallam County called a ban as well. The land clearing permits we had on file, have been suspended. Going over complaints in the report, R. Moody noted there are several complaints related to the homeless camp in Olympia known as the Jungle. This is one of two areas covered by our agreement with OlyMAP (Olympia Mutual Aid Partners), discussed at earlier meetings. This agreement has enabled OlyMAP to work with camp residents to do several camp cleanups. Another important part of the agreement is that we send complaint information to OlyMAP, and they send staff out into the camps to try to address the issues. Regarding the complaint listed in the report, OlyMAP made contact with the individual burning plastic and was able to help and educate them, as well as provide direct service to the individual. This is a valuable service to ORCAA.

Brotherton noted Jefferson County has issued a fire safety burn ban early this year. Johnston noted that Thurston and Pacific are the only counties in our jurisdiction that have yet to call a fire safety burn ban.

Myers asked about the Westport penalties – R. Moody explained it was a series of violations of federal regulations that limit the amount of styrene they can emit. During COVID they had difficulty getting their regular resin and chose to use a different kind. Violations occurred over 22 months – the penalty shown is the settlement and it has been paid.

Cooper asked if the suspended burn permits can be used in the fall. R. Moody noted they will need to reapply in the fall.

#### Engineering Manager Update

Goodin noted the list of Industrial / Commercial permits on the Engineering Report is short due to few applications coming to ORCAA. We are spending a lot of time on larger source AOP permits— Weyerhaeuser, SPI in Shelton, Crown Cork, and Seal, etc. Goodin gave a brief summary of the AOPs currently being worked. Goodin explained another aspect of the work the engineers do is the up-front (and sometimes after the fact) work we call "First Contact." We track planned projects, and deal with after-the-fact projects. Goodin explained what these items covered and how much time they take.

Gooding explained a couple of our engineers recently attended stack test training at the Department of Ecology in Lacey. When we issue permits, we include stack test methods, and specifics related to a myriad of rules and regulations. Goodin added, he presented a pending compliance case at a Title V and New Source Review workshop in Portland last month. The engineering team is also wrapping up emissions inventory work for the year. This is an exceptionally long process and takes most of the year to complete and is done between writing and issuing permits.

Goodin did want to note this is a temporary valley with regard to new permits. Cooper asked if the valley is due to the broader economy or COVID. Goodin stated he was unsure as to the cause. Johnston added it is different everywhere, talking to the different local air agencies, it is inconsistent. Not all agencies are experiencing the same drop-off in applications that ORCAA is seeing.

#### Senior Air Monitoring Specialist Update

Hadley noted good air quality in all of our counties in May. We did have issues in Lacey, resulting in only 9 days of data, so many days were invalidated due to quality assurance procedures. Port Angeles was short a couple of days due to an instrument failure. We actually made the news because the Port Angeles monitor showed, erroneously, that air quality was in the red (unhealthy) category.

The ozone slide did not load properly, however Hadley stated the correlation between monitors at the Lacey site is great. The Grays Harbor Saturation Study will be conducted through July, and she will then start analyzing the data. Noting the one high peak on the coast, Hadley believes it is due to campfires on the beach.

Hadley went over the other monitoring news, including the Cheeka Peak project. Hadley explained we have signed a contract with A-Action group to conduct Cheeka Peak site cleanup and grading.

Hadley shared, she and Nancy Wood-Siglin conducted 2 workshops for the Annual Expanding Your Horizons program. Hadley asked Wood-Siglin to report on the program. Wood-Siglin explained this involves middle school aged girls and is a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) program. There was a total of 17 workshops, and they focus on women in science-based jobs. Hadley added ORCAA has been participating in this program for about 20 years.

Brotherton noted there has been interest in additional monitoring in Jefferson County. Brotherton recalled issues with Purple Air sensors and asked if they are still suggested for use in locations such as schools and libraries. Hadley stated Purple Air is aware they over predict and have in place, fixes for them so people can see the correct values. Correlation with our other monitors is very good, Hadley stated, so yes, those are the devices we recommend.

Brotherton asked if we should place Purple Air Monitors in all our counties? Can ORCAA buy in bulk and get a discount for the jurisdiction? Hadley was not sure about discounts. However, she noted increasingly more are popping up in our jurisdiction. Brotherton also asked about clean air shelters in Jefferson County. Should we be monitoring inside? Hadley said Purple Airs can be used indoors.

Cooper asked if there is a backup system when CPO is down for upgrades during wildfire season. Hadley explained Neah Bay has a monitor, but for us yes, it will all be down for 2-3 weeks. (Mejia joined the meeting, 11 am, via Zoom).

#### Communications Manager Update

Nelson noted this week is "Smoke Ready Week". This is a national effort, but the Northwest Air Quality Communicators group has been very active in developing content to push out to social media during the week. We are doing outreach with targeted messaging each day, on social media that is being used across Washington, Oregon, and Idaho, all with consistent information. In discussing ORCAA's social media efforts, Nelson mentioned ORCAA's Nextdoor page which covers all 6 counties. Nelson is able to turn off discussions in Nextdoor, which limits some of the negative aspects of this platform. On Facebook we do allow discussion as people chose to "follow" ORCAA on their own.

Nelson did go to Port Townsend with the Washington Department of Health to discuss wildfire smoke preparation. He also did a similar presentation at a Thurston County event on May 31. Nelson noted he is editing a video of staff showing how to make DIY air filters using box fans and furnace filters. He hopes to have them posted on the ORCAA website soon.

The woodstove grant program is wrapping up for the year and we are already working to make sure our next 2-year grant cycle is even more effective than the current one. Nelson plans to propose that we extend the \$500 wood stove recycle award to all of our jurisdiction.

Nelson shared that iPhone and Google Maps has an option to show an air quality layer with real time data.

Nelson acknowledged we will have a busy summer. Nelson stated he did just get the Jefferson County burn ban information and we will need to collaborate with them to make sure we get their press releases in a timely way.

In referring to the "Agency Update & Financial Summary" document included with the Board packet, Nelson mentioned that in the past ORCAA did detailed annual reports and this year we decided to do a more concise summary. We highlighted some things from last year and noted our plans for the coming year.

#### Financial Services Manager Update

Harding said we have paid off our building and received our final paperwork. Harding shared we have added new flooring on our tenant side and recently bought a new street sign. We hired Dave Nelson for groundskeeping and minor maintenance around the building. We do have additional operating and maintenance improvements scheduled for this coming year; Harding noted.

Brotherton asked if Thurston County is our bank and how are they doing. Harding stated Thurston County manages our funds and they are doing well.

#### Executive Director Update

Johnston noted that while we have had some long standing and significant compliance issues with a few of our sources, we are making progress in resolving the issues. He hopes to be able to say more at the July meeting. Johnston stated he participated remotely in a couple of national and international meetings in May. (11:19 am, Mejia arrives in person). The spring meeting of the National Association of Clean Air Agencies (NACAA) was held in mid-May, and the spring meeting of the Georgia Basin Puget Sound International Air Shed Committee met last week. The latter is a group of federal, state, provincial, and local government agencies in Washington and British Columbia.

Johnston said he is currently serving as chair for the Washington Air Quality Managers Group, which includes the directors of the seven local air agencies and the air quality program manager from the Department of Ecology.

Johnston reminded the Board we will be meeting in July, but at this point there isn't anything on the agenda other than the standing program reports. Please let us know if there is something the Board would like to see on the agenda.

Cooper reminded the members, there is an agenda planner for Board members to check to see what's coming up in the months ahead.

#### GOOD OF THE ORDER

Brotherton liked that his joke from last month made it to the Minutes. He asked about AI and wondered if this is something staff has discussed. As public agencies, Brotherton felt we could be

leaders. Johnston noted we have had internal conversations but nothing in depth, if you have ideas how public agencies have used it or are pursuing uses, we would like to hear about them.

Goodin added he did try AI on a permit condition and his opinion was it gave a good starting point, but it is not there yet. Brotherton suggested adding our own information into ChatGPT4. Neatherlin mentioned, be careful, garbage in garbage out. Cooper added he is cautious, but also doesn't want to be left behind. Johnston encouraged members to send info to us with regards to examples of how other agencies are using generative AI.

Cooper reminded the group we will be back to fully virtual meetings next month.

After adjournment, Cooper asked everyone to join staff out back for the celebration.

### **Explanation of Compliance Reports**

Common to all of these reports is the choice of "city" as the mailing address for the activity.

#### **Inspections Completed**

This report lists the initials \* of the ORCAA inspector (or engineer), the date the inspection was achieved, the ORCAA file number, business name, and the nearest city for their location.

RTM – Robert Moody, Compliance Manager MS – Mike Shults, Compliance Supervisor RDW – Robert Wyland, Air Quality Specialist II NWS – Nancy Wood Siglin, Air Quality Specialist II BTD – Bryson Downs, Air Quality Specialist I MVG – Mark Goodin, Engineering Manager JAD – Jennifer DeMay, Engineering Supervisor AM – Aaron Manley, Engineer II LEW – Lauren Whybrew, Engineer I

The 'Inspection Type" column is a record of how the inspection was accomplished, or the purpose of the inspection.

- **Full Compliance Evaluation** is selected when a complete on on-site inspection was achieved. This indicates there was a facility walk-through, equipment was checked, and records were reviewed.
- **Partial Compliance Evaluation** is selected with an on- or off-site inspection was conducted that was not comprehensive (i.e. records review only). Many partial inspections can add up to a full inspection. This has been used more frequently since COVID.
- Investigation is an on- or off-site examination of a specific parameter or issue.
- **Source Test** is chosen when ORCAA is on-site to observe independent test companies as they audit a buisiness' emissions.
- **Driveby** is documentation that we have been to the business but did not enter the property. This code is used for following up on complaints (when no action is necessary) or checking up on businesses that have been problematic.

#### **Asbestos Permit Status Report**

The "**Rec'd**" is the date the permit was received at ORCAA. The "**Site address**" and "**County**" is the where the project is to occur. The "**Completion Date**" is proposed by the applicant stating when the project should be completed.

#### **Demolition Notifications Report**

Similar to the asbestos report, however because these notifications are good for an entire year, the list is long.

Additional headings, different from the Asbestos Report include: The "**Staff**" indicates which staff person The "Address" and "City" is the where the project is to occur.

The "**Status**" includes comments from staff handling the notification. The comments allow any inspector to follow up on any permit.

The "**Asb Survey**" is a checkbox indicating whether ORCAA received an asbestos survey prior to the demolition.

The "Asb Permit #" coincides with an asbestos project in our system for the same address.

#### **Current ORCAA Land Clearing Burn Permit**

This report contains active permits.

The **"FireDistrict#**" is the district in which the burn will take place. The **"Expiration**" is the final date the permit is valid. The **"#**" is the permit number assigned by ORCAA. **"Burn Site Address**" and **"City**" is the location of the burn.

#### **Complaint Report**

These are alleged violations of air quality regulations. Not all have been investigated on-site by an ORCAA inspector.

The "Source" references the alleged polluter, whether a business or individual

The "City" is the where the alleged violation occurred

The "**Formal**" checkbox is used to denote when a Formal Complaint has been received from the complainant. A Formal Complaint is a form that documents what occurred and is signed by the complainant and notarized. It includes details such as time of day, date, health impacts, and authorization to release the complainants name during the investigation.

The "**Online**" checkbox is used to document complaints that have been submitted via email. The check boxes for **smoke**, **odor**, **open fire**, **dust**, **woodstove**, **asbestos/demo**, **marijuana**, and **other** are used to characterize the nature of the complaint.

#### **NOV Monthly Report**

This is a list of Notices of Violation (NOV) that had action during the reporting period. Action items may include the issuance of the NOV, issuance of the penalty amount (by law we must wait at least 30 days from the issuance of an NOV to assess a penalty) or show a penalty has been paid.




