Cooper called the meeting to order at 10 a.m. and asked for roll call.

#### **APPROVAL OF AGENDA** (2:15)

Cooper asked for approval of the agenda. Brotherton moved approval, the motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### **CHAIR REPORT** (3:00)

Cooper requested Brotherton give an update on the Finance Committee meeting.

Brotherton reported on the year-end report for Fiscal Year 2023 and gave an update on a discussion related to succession planning and proposed FY2024 budget revision.

Johnston presented the current and proposed ORCAA organizational chart after explaining the upcoming staff retirement timing. (5:00)

There was no action from the Board.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA** (11:46)

Cooper asked approval of the Consent Agenda. Tobin moved approval of the Consent Agenda. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

#### Rule 1.11 and 1.12 updates (12:30)

R. Moody briefly explained the rule process and need for the change, noting we are seeking approval of the amendment.

Cooper opened the public hearing at 10:15 am. There were no public comments, Cooper closed the public hearing at 10:15 am.

Cooper asked for a motion. Vazquez moved to approve the rule change. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### **PRESENTATION**

#### Cheeka Peak Observatory (CPO) (16:10)

Hadley presented photos – before and after – and described the work to upgrade the CPO facilities.

#### DIRECTORS REPORT

#### Compliance Manager Update (31:47)

R. Moody explained we have purchased a vehicle to replace an older vehicle and reminded the Board outdoor burning will be opening soon.

#### Engineering Manager Update (33:36)

Goodin went over the permitting report, highlighting new permits for Pacific Northwest Renewables, Hoquiam Plywood, Weyerhaeuser Raymond, Crown Cork & Seal, and Lakeside Industries. Goodin also went over several proposed permits including AGP, Westport Shipyard, and Paneltech.

#### Senior Air Monitoring Specialist Update (54:54)

Hadley introduced Rob Wyland, Air Quality Specialist 2. Wyland went over the air monitoring report for July and August.

#### Communications Manager Update (58:18)

Nelson noted activities over the previous 2 months including Harbor Days in Olympia and Coffee with Commissioner Carolina Mejia.

Nelson explained the imminent end to the current fire safety burn bans and provided an update on the new Ecology grant funding our woodstove replacement and recycling programs.

#### Finance Services Manager Update (1:05:12)

Harding went over recent building maintenance projects, both inside and outside. Harding explained the AWC WellCity program and described some recent ORCAA's Wellness Program efforts.

#### Executive Director Update (1:13:50)

Johnston went over his outreach efforts within our jurisdiction, mentioned ORCAA completed a cybersecurity audit with the State Auditor's Office and received high marks. Johnston also noted a change to our approach to meeting minutes, moving to an "action minutes" approach. Starting with today's meetings (Finance Committee and Board) we will focus on recording what is done at a meeting, rather than what is said.

Johnston explained he will be participating in the Leadership Thurston County program and mentioned that the EPA is looking for nominations for their Local Government Advisory Committee.

#### **Executive Director to serve as Hearing Officer**

**WHEREAS**, the Olympic Region Clean Air Agency (ORCAA) is governed by the ORCAA Board of Directors (Board); and

**WHEREAS**, ORCAA Rule 1.7(a) permits the Board to appoint the Executive Director of the Agency to hold hearings under the provisions of chapter 70A.15 RCW;

**WHEREAS**, ORCAA Rule 6.1.3(e) provides that the Agency may, in its discretion, hold a public hearing if it determines significant public interest regarding a Notice of Construction (NOC) application exists;

**WHEREAS**, WAC 173-401-800(4) provides that the permitting authority may, in its discretion, hold a public hearing if it determines significant public interest regarding an Air Operating Permit (AOP) application exists.

**WHEREAS**, ORCAA has direct authority to implement and enforce Washington's Operating Permit Regulation under Chapter 173-401 WAC; and,

**WHEREAS**, the ORCAA Board of Directors wishes to appoint Executive Director, Jeff Johnston, to serve as Hearing Officer at any public hearings in conjunction with NOC and AOP applications, under provisions of chapter 70A.15 RCW, as provided in ORCAA Regulation 1.7.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the ORCAA Board of Directors hereby appoint the Executive Director, or his designee, to serve as the Hearing Officer at any hearings as permitted or required pursuant to ORCAA Rules 6.1.3(e), Rule 1.7(a) or WAC 173-401-800(4), as described above.

The 'Inspection Type" column is a record of how the inspection was accomplished, or the purpose of the inspection.

- Full Compliance Evaluation is selected when a complete on on-site inspection was achieved.
   This indicates there was a facility walk-through, equipment was checked, and records were reviewed.
- Partial Compliance Evaluation is selected with an on- or off-site inspection was conducted that was not comprehensive (i.e. records review only). Many partial inspections can add up to a full inspection. This has been used more frequently since COVID.
- **Investigation** is an on- or off-site examination of a specific parameter or issue.
- **Source Test** is chosen when ORCAA is on-site to observe independent test companies as they audit a buisiness' emissions.
- **Driveby** is documentation that we have been to the business but did not enter the property. This code is used for following up on complaints (when no action is necessary) or checking up on businesses that have been problematic.

#### **Asbestos Permit Status Report**

The "Rec'd" is the date the permit was received at ORCAA.

The "Site address" and "County" is the where the project is to occur.

The "Completion Date" is proposed by the applicant stating when the project should be completed.

#### **Demolition Notifications Report**

Similar to the asbestos report, however because these notifications are good for an entire year, the list is long.

Additional headings, different from the Asbestos Report include:

The "Staff" indicates which staff person

The "Address" and "City" is the where the project is to occur.

The "Status" includes comments from staff handling the notification. The comments allow any inspector to follow up on any permit.

The "Asb Survey" is a checkbox indicating whether ORCAA received an asbestos survey prior to the demolition.

The "Asb Permit #" coincides with an asbestos project in our system for the same address.

#### **Current ORCAA Land Clearing Burn Permit**

This report contains active permits.

The "FireDistrict#" is the district in which the burn will take place.

The "Expiration" is the final date the permit is valid.

The "#" is the permit number assigned by ORCAA.

"Burn Site Address" and "City" is the location of the burn.

#### **Complaint Report**

These are alleged violations of air quality regulations. Not all have been investigated on-site by an ORCAA inspector.

The "Source" references the alleged polluter, whether a business or individual

The "City" is the where the alleged violation occurred

The "Formal" checkbox is used to denote when a Formal Complaint has been received from the complainant. A Formal Complaint is a form that documents what occurred and is signed by the complainant and notarized. It includes details such as time of day, date, health impacts, and authorization to release the complainants name during the investigation.

The "Online" checkbox is used to document complaints that have been submitted via email.

The check boxes for **smoke**, **odor**, **open fire**, **dust**, **woodstove**, **asbestos/demo**, **marijuana**, and **other** are used to characterize the nature of the complaint.

#### **New Source Review**

- NOC Notice of Construction. Required prior to the construction, installation, replacement, or modification of air pollution sources, emissions units, or air pollution control equipment in ORCAA's region.
- NOR Notice of Revision. This is a permit action initiated by the source owner to revise a
  condition when there is no associated emissions increase or installation that would trigger a
  NOC.
- ADM Administrative Amendments. ORCAA may need to amend previously issued NOCs to correct material errors (e.g., typos, misnumbering, etc.)

#### **Air Operating Permits**

- AOP Air Operating Permits. AOPs are permits issued to operate sources of air pollution that emit major quantities of air pollution. AOPs must be reissued every 5 years.
- **REV Revisions.** Revisions to AOPs can be requested by the source through an administrative amendment or permit modification.
- **RFC Reopen for Cause.** ORCAA is required to reopen an AOP for cause under certain circumstances (e.g., additional applicable requirements become applicable, the permit contains a material mistake, etc.).

#### **Other Applications/Notifications**

- **SMO Synthetic Minor Order.** Application to limit a facility's potential to emit to ensure the facility's actual emissions are below major source thresholds.
- NOI Notice of Intent. A notification submitted to the Agency for certain activities listed in ORCAA Rule 6.4 (e.g., relocation of a portable source, nonroad engine, small unit exemption, etc.).

The "NOC No" is the ORCAA-assigned application number.

The "Facility Category" describes the general type of industry category of the facility.

The "Description" is a brief description of the applicant's proposal.

The "Eng" lists the initials of the ORCAA engineer assigned to review the application:



# Got an old wood stove or fireplace insert?

## New REBATES make it affordable to upgrade to an energy-efficient appliance

To help reduce the amount of Particulate Matter pollution (PM2.5) in the the areas with the highest levels of smoke pollution within our jurisdiction, this **Wood Stove Replacement program** is available for residents of Thurston and Mason Counties as well as the eastern, more densely populated, areas of Clallam and Jefferson Counties (that is, area east of the Elwha River in Clallam County, and east of

Olympic National Park in Jefferson County). The funding is provided by the Washington Department of Ecology through a Wood Smoke Reduction Grant.

### The following terms apply:

- 1. This Wood Stove Recycling Award is available for residents of Thurston and Mason Counties and the eastern areas of Clallam and Jefferson Counties (that is, area east of the Elwha River in Clallam County, and east of Olympic National Park in Jefferson County
- 2. Residents of those cities and UGAs must remove and destroy one or more of the following:
  - a wood stove or fireplace insert that is NOT compliant with 2020 New Source Performance Standards
- 3. Residents who qualify for the above may receive rebates in the following amounts:
  - \$1,000 for installation of any natural gas, propane, electric 'fire' device, or pellet stove or insert,
  - \$2,000 for installation of high-efficiency heat pumps, including Ductless Heat Pumps (DHP).
  - \$500 RECYCLING AWARD for the removal and destruction of a wood stove (no new installation required)

# Got an old wood stove or fireplace insert?

## New **RECYCLING AWARD** provides \$\$ to remove old, inefficient woodstoves

The Olympic Region Clean Air Agency (ORCAA) works to protect air quality for its citizens. One of the primary pollutants within ORCAA's jurisdiction is fine Particulate Matter ( $PM_{2.5}$ ) and the main source of that pollutant is burning. With the removal of just 120 solid-fuel home heating devices from the community, residents will reduce emissions by 20 tons of  $PM_{2.5}$  per year.

To help reduce the amount of PM<sub>2.5</sub> in the all six counties within our jurisdiction ORCAA has secured a Wood Smoke Reduction grant from the Washington Department of Ecology to provide wood stove RECYCLING AWARDS.

### The following terms apply:

- 1. This Wood Stove Recycling Award is available for residents of Clallam, Grays Harbor, Jefferson, Mason, Pacific, and Thurston Counties. The funding is provided by the Washington Department of Ecology through a Wood Smoke Reduction Grant.
- 2. Residents of those cities and UGAs must remove and destroy one or more of the following:
  - a wood stove or fireplace insert that is NOT compliant with 2020 New Source Performance Standards



- 3. Residents who qualify for the above may receive the RECYCLING AWARD of:
  - \$500 for to remove and destroy an old, uncertified wood appliance.
