SUBJECT: LOTT Clean Water Alliance Notice of Construction Application for the **Centrate Building Rehabilitation Project**

Enclosed please find the completed notice of construction, and permit fee for LOTT's planned Centrate Building Rehabilitation Project. The project rehabilitates the centrate handling facility and will replace the entire roof structure, refurbish structural steel support components, upgrade electrical and control systems, reinforce the walls to meet current seismic code, replace the air handling and foul air treatment systems, rehabilitate the basins, and install influent gates, actuators, and controls. Rooftop solar panels will also be added.

The odor treatment system will include four new scrubbers and the associated fans, variable frequency drives (VFD), and ducting. Additional design and equipment details will be provided with a separate submission.

Hi Nicole,

I am requesting concurrence with our decision not to do SEPA on this project. We are rehabilitating the Centrate building and the description of it is below.

My reading of the law is that this falls under WAC 197-11-800 Categorical Exemption, part (3) Repair, remodeling, and maintenance activities: The following activities shall be categorically exempt: The repair, remodeling, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing private or public structures, facilities or equipment, including utilities, recreation, and transportation facilities involving no material expansions or changes in use beyond that previously existing...

Centrate Building Description:

The project rehabilitates the facility and will replace the entire roof structure, refurbish structural steel support components, upgrade electrical and control systems, reinforce the walls to meet current seismic code, replace the air handling and foul air treatment systems, rehabilitate the basins, and install influent gates, actuators, and controls. Rooftop solar panels will also be added. A temporary pumping and piping system will be installed to bypass the facility during construction.

Roofing – The roofing system will include a new deck pan, insulation, and membrane. Access ladders and handrails will be added to improve safe access for maintenance on the roof.

Odor Control – New fans, ducting, and hydrogen sulfide scrubbers will be installed to provide proper air exchanges to minimize odor concentrations within the building as well as air being discharged to the atmosphere. Consistent with LOTT policies, the scrubbers will reduce odors to a level below noticeable concentrations at the treatment plant property lines.

Influent Flow Control – New gates, actuators, and controls will be added, allowing control of influent flow to the facility during high flow events for primary treatment. This will add an additional 22 mgd of primary treatment, improving LOTT's ability to adapt to more intense storm events and reduce the risk of combined sewer overflow events.

Electrical and Controls – All electrical components (lighting, receptacles, conduits, motors, actuators, etc.) will be replaced/upgraded to meet explosion proof requirements (NFPA Class 1, Division 1) necessary for using the facility as primary clarifiers.

Solar Panels - The project also includes the installation of a rooftop solar array, utilizing the approximately 16,000 square feet of space on the roof, which is estimated to provide 196,000 kWh/year in electricity to charge LOTT's electrical vehicle fleet.

Excavation- Some minor excavation will occur to provide concrete bases for the support columns of a lean-to roof structure over the outdoor motor control centers (MCCs). Excavation will be limited to approximately $2' \times 2' \times 2'$, where the concrete bases will be installed.
