Riverside Forest Products USA, Inc. (RFP) plans to install a new sawmill at a location within the Forks Industrial Park, in Forks, Washington. A signed and dated Olympic Region Clean Air Agency (ORCAA) Form 1 Notice of Construction (NOC) application is enclosed with this letter, as well as a check payable to ORCAA in the amount of \$4,990. The amount of the check is based on our interpretation of how the NOC Fee Schedule available on ORCAA's website applies to the equipment planned for the new sawmill. It is our understanding that if ORCAA determines that the fee is insufficient, review of our submitted application will proceed, and ORCAA will invoice RFP for the additional amount; an Order of Approval will not be issued until that invoice is paid. An electronic version of the NOC application form with a signed and dated State Environmental Policy Act checklist and other supporting information will be submitted to ORCAA via email.


