PROJECT DESCRIPTION: International Paper Olympia (IP) is an existing containerboard facility in Lacey, Washington. IP is requesting to modify their voluntary synthetic minor order 06SMO472 to update emission factors for the corrugator and trim system cyclone handling waste paper emissions, and to add the starch silo as a source of PM emissions. IP will continue to be considered a synthetic minor source with respect to the Washington State Operating Permit Regulations in Chapter 173-401 WAC.

ORCAA reviewed IP's request and concludes that compliance with applicable air regulations and standards will likely be maintained. On this basis, ORCAA recommends that IP's request be conditionally approved.
