DRAFT PERMIT NOTICE: A draft renewal of the Air Operating Permit (AOP) for the Simpson Door Company (Simpson Door) manufacturing plant located in McCleary, Washington, is available for review.

BACKGROUND: Simpson Door is a wood door manufacturing plant located at 400 Simpson Avenue in McCleary, Washington. The plant produces wood doors and has been in existence since the early 1940s. Simpson Door requires an AOP because it has the potential to emit over 100 tons per year of particulate air pollution. AOPs are required under the Washington Clean Air Act and are designed to help ensure compliance with applicable air quality regulations and standards. This will be the fourth renewal of the AOP for the Simpson Door plant.

DOCUMENT AVAILABILITY: Copies of the draft AOP Renewal and the associated Technical Support Document (TSD) for Simpson Door are on file and available for review at the McCleary Timberland Public Library located at 121 South 4th Street in McCleary, and at ORCAA's office in Olympia. Comments may also be emailed to info@orcaa.org. Comments will be accepted up to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, June 29, 2018. Comments should pertain to adequacy of the draft AOP and TSD in assuring compliance with applicable air quality regulations and standards. Any concerned party may request a public hearing within the specified public comment period. The request should include information to justify the need for a public hearing. If there is significant public interest, ORCAA will hold a public hearing.
