Training Fire Notification

All live fire training on structures requires the completion, submittal, and approval of this notification. The following conditions must be met prior to training (RCW 52.12.150 and RCW 70A.15.5180(3)).

RCW 70A.15.5180(5) and WAC 173-425-050(1)(b) allows the limited burning of prohibited materials to provide for fire fighting instruction training. Therefore, all prohibited materials not deemed essential to the training activity, such as furniture, carpeting, and other prohibited materials shall be removed.

CONDITIONS:

1. The fire must conform to any other permits, licenses, or approvals that are required;
2. The fire must not occur during an ORCAA declared Impaired Air Quality Curtailment; this does not include the summer burn restriction.
3. Nuisance laws are applicable to the fire. ORCAA may ask that the training fire be extinguished prior to training completion if it becomes a nuisance. This includes nuisances related to the unreasonable interference with the enjoyment of life and property and the depositing of particulate matter or ash on other property;
4. Notice of the fire must be provided to the owners of property adjoining the property on which the fire will occur, to other persons who could be potentially impacted by the fire, and to additional persons in a broader manner as specifically requested by ORCAA;
5. Each structure proposed to be set on fire must be identified specifically as a structure to be burned. All other structures on the same parcel of property that are not proposed to be burned must be identified as such;
6. Before setting a structure on fire, an inspection must be conducted to determine if asbestos-containing materials are present. An ORCAA Demolition (and if applicable, an Asbestos Notification) must accompany this form. All persons who inspect for asbestos-containing materials (must have AHERA certification (40 CFR 763) and inspect using procedures contained in 40 CFR 763.86 and 40 CFR 763.87. The inspection must be documented in writing and forwarded to ORCAA. Any asbestos that is found must be removed as required by local, state, and federal laws;
7. All mercury containing thermostats and switches must be identified, properly removed, and safely disposed of prior to setting a structure on fire;
8. A copy of this form must be available on site during the burn.
9. By igniting the training fire, the fire protection agency accepts all responsibility for fire suppression costs incurred, or damage sustained, by any person or property. If the fire escapes, the fire protection agency shall be responsible for paying for the people and equipment for fire suppression, as required by Chapter 76.04 RCW.
